*"Therefore, there is now no condemnation for those who are in Christ Jesus."* -Romans 8:1

*"If we confess our sins, He is faithful and just and will forgive us our sins and purify us from all unrighteousness."* -1 John 1:9

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## II. GODLY REPENTANCE PRODUCES:

1. \_\_\_\_\_ (Earnestness)

*"wake up call"*

2. \_\_\_\_\_ (Eagerness to clear yourselves)

*"to be honest about sin- to fess up"*

3. \_\_\_\_\_ (Indignation)

*"to be oppressed in your mind over your sin"*

*"When the sinner moans inwardly with himself, finds fault with himself, and is angry with himself, while recognizing his own ungratefulness toward God..."* - John Calvin

4. \_\_\_\_\_ (Alarm)

*"fear or terror - also reverence or respect"*

5. \_\_\_\_\_ (Longing)

*"readiness to obey"*

6. \_\_\_\_\_ (Concern)

*"the motivation produced in us"*

7. \_\_\_\_\_ (Readiness to see justice done)

*"vengeance or vindictive justice"*

The more severe we are with ourselves and the more sharply we examine our own sins the more we ought to hope in God's love and mercy toward us.
